**Emergency Medical Responder
(EMR)**

This course, formerly known as First Responder, is an introductory course that will prepare you to become nationally or state certified. This course covers all aspects, responsibilities, and duties for providing emergency care. You will be able to provide direct patient care in a variety of medical emergency situations, identify and understand your legal, moral and ethical responsibilities, and will work and perform as a health care professional. **Emergency Medical Responder
Transition/Refresher**

This course covers modules taught in the Emergency Medical Responder course. Keep your credential up to date by taking this refresher course. Topics include emergency care, medical/legal and ethical issues, lifting and moving, airway skills management, CPR AED refresher, patient assessment, and trauma emergencies, plus more.

Fire Fighter 1 Academy, 02

This course provides basic knowledge and skills to successfully complete Fire Fighter I certification exam. This challenging "hands-on" course is designed for a candidate to be placed in a fire department to the best of their ability. Other requirements include having had Hazardous Materials Awareness and Hazardous Materials Operations training and basic First Aid or higher. Text required.
