PROPOSITIONS

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Shall Independent School District Number 1 of Comanche County, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of Thirty Seven Million One Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$37,170,000) to be issued in series to provide funds for the purpose of constructing, equipping, repairing and remodeling school buildings, acquiring school furniture, fixtures and equipment and acquiring and improving school sites, and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in such District sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest

not to exceed the rate of ten (10%) percentum per annum, payable semi-annually and to become due serially within five (5) years from their date?

PROPOSITION NO. 2

Shall Independent School District Number 1 of Comanche County, Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its bonds in the sum of One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000) to be issued in series to provide funds for the purpose of purchasing transportation equipment, and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in such District sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to bear interest not to exceed the rate of ten (10%) percentum per annum, payable semi-annually and to become due serially within five (5) years from their date?



PROPOSITION

Shall Ordinance No. 15-20 of the City of Lawton, Oklahoma be approved, which levies and assesses a continuation of a hotel occupancy tax at the rate of a modest increase from five percent (5%) to five and one-half percent (5.5%) for a period of five (5) years, beginning May 1, 2016, on the rents received from the occupancy of hotel/motel rooms, unless such tax is extended by a subsequent vote of the electorate; providing that the revenues from the tax collected be placed in a special fund of the city and appropriated annually for the exclusive purposes of encouraging, promoting and fostering conventions, tourism, industrial development and economic development in the City of Lawton; and providing that the Lawton City Council may enter into agreements for accomplishing the purposes
