AN ICE STORM WARNING REMAINS IN EFFECT FROM 6 PM THIS EVENING TO 6 AM CST SUNDAY. * MAIN IMPACT: WIDESPREAD FREEZING RAIN WILL DEVELOP EARLY THIS EVENING AND CONTINUE SATURDAY. ICE ACCUMULATIONS OF AROUND ONE-HALF INCH WILL BE POSSIBLE ACROSS PORTIONS OF WESTERN...CENTRAL AND NORTH-CENTRAL OKLAHOMA. THIS ICE WILL ACCUMULATE MAINLY ON TREES AND POWERLINES AND RESULT IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF SLICK BRIDGES...OVERPASSES AND WALKWAYS. SCATTERED POWER OUTAGES ARE EXPECTED. * OTHER IMPACTS: FREEZING RAIN AND RAIN WILL CHANGE TO SNOW LATE SATURDAY AFTERNOON OR EVENING. ACCUMULATION OF 2 TO 4 INCHES WILL BE POSSIBLE ACROSS NORTHERN OKLAHOMA WITH LIGHTER AMOUNTS FARTHER SOUTH. PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS... DO NOT TRAVEL IN ICY CONDITIONS. BE SURE YOU CAN TAKE CARE OF YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY IF YOU LOSE ELECTRICAL POWER. WATCH OUT FOR FALLING TREES...LIMBS AND POWER LINES.
