

Settlements Reached on Goodyear and Sanders Heights Protests

On Monday, the Comanche County commissioners approved payment to J. W. Doolin, attorney at law, for his services in the settlements with Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company and Sanders Heights Apartments. This marks the end of a long court struggle. Goodyear protested the assessment of their property value for 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014. The initial assessment under Richard Strickland evaluated Goodyear at \$92.3 million. After having a private commercial appraisal company assess the value of their property, Goodyear came back that the value was only worth \$23 million. The four year court struggle has finally ended with a settlement of \$45 million. Sanders Heights Apartment contested their original property assessment of \$3 million in 2014. They have also reached a settlement at \$1.4 million.
