This year, the City of Lawton passed an ordinance that makes it illegal to shoot off fireworks on all city property. This includes Lake Ellsworth and Lake Lawtonka, where residents were previously allowed to display on the 4th of July. However, there is no such ordinance in Comanche County. For the 4th, if you are outside city limits, but still in Comanche County, you can display your fireworks. If you are going to shoot off fireworks in the county this year, do so safely and have precautions for sparks or fire. Even though we are no longer in a drought, a fire can still start easily if safety is not being practiced. Also, be considerate of others and the environment and clean up your firework debris. If you don't want to shoot off your own fireworks this year, there are some opportunities to watch a display. The City of Lawton will be putting on a professional fireworks display at Elmer Thomas Park, and the Sterling Volunteer Fire Department will be putting on their own display at Ike Williams Park.
