Governor Mary Fallin Requests Major Disaster Declaration for 6 Oklahoma Counties

OKLAHOMA CITY – Governor Mary Fallin today announced the state of Oklahoma has requested a major disaster declaration for six Oklahoma counties.

Fallin requested public assistance to aid municipalities, counties, rural electric cooperatives and the state.

The counties ~~Adair, Comanche, Cotton, Garvin, Grady~~ assistance are:

Severe weather that began June 11 caused flash flooding that drenched homes, businesses and vehicles.

Preliminary damage assessments indicate the storms resulted in more than \$6.7 million in infrastructure damage.

Also today, ~~Adair, Comanche~~ federal government ~~Garvin~~ denied the state's request for 300 homes.

The state still is working to bring assistance to those impacted by the storm through a request for a disaster declaration.
